Regarding: Approval for the yearly solid waste grant

Executive summary: This memo is to request Sierra County Board of approval for a yearly grant request. Each year the County applies for a Local Enforcement Agency Grant to fund these mandated programs. The program assures that solid, liquid, and hazardous wastes are reclaimed, or recycled. The effort of this grant is to prevent the spreading of pollution, especially in water, nuisance environmental hazards and wastes of any kind.

Background: Local enforcement agencies (LEA) are designated by the governing body of a county or city and, upon certification by CalRecycle, are empowered to implement delegated CalRecycle programs and locally designated activities. LEAs have the primary responsibility for ensuring the correct operation and closure of solid waste facilities in the state. They also have responsibilities for guaranteeing the proper storage and transportation of solid wastes.

Fiscal Impact: There is no impact in the general fund; this \$ 15,580.00 grant is used to partially fund salaries and training/travel in the health department.

Recommendation: The Sierra County HHS Director recommends this annual renewal.

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, Grant Application procedures require an Applicant's governing body to authorize by resolution its approval for submittal of the Local Enforcement Agency Grant Application, and the designation by job title of the individual authorized to execute in the name of Sierra County, the application for the securing of grant funds; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, Sierra County will enter into a Grant Agreement with the CalRecycle for implementation of said Grant; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Sierra County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of an application for the Local Enforcement Agency Grant (EA27 - FY 2016/17), and authorizes Darden Bynum, the Director of Sierra County Human Services or his/her designee to sign Grant documents for securing the Grant funds; and that the grant agreement will be returned to the Board of Supervisors for final approval; and

BE FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective for the 2016/17, FY Grant.
