Agenda Item: Review and approval of request to temporarily close Jean Lane, a County road in Sierraville, for a period not exceeding sixty (60) days to allow the owners of Sierraville Service to construct a new underground fuel dispensing and storage apparatus.

Background:


The owners of Sierraville Service are upgrading the fuel storage and dispensing system on the property and due to the location of the system in relation to Jean Lane, a closure of the road is necessary to allow construction and delivery of materials as well as avoidance of any liability. The owner/contractor installing the system will be filing an application for encroachment permit to perform construction on and within the road right of way and to obtain a proper temporary closure of the road. The California Streets and Highways code vest a decision to close a road to the Board of Supervisors unless it has been delegated to the Director of Transportation/Road Commissioner. It is not clear if such a delegation has ever occurred and in the absence of any document, the conservative approach in this case is to request approval from the Board of Supervisors for this closure.

The road dead ends at Sierraville Creek and only one property owner to the east (Moreau) uses this road for access. In this case, a bridge connecting the County road to the property owned by this individual is in existence but is classified as a violation as the bridge connection to the County road has never been approved. The bridge was constructed without permits or proper inspection prior to her acquisition of the property and to date, the County has not indicated its approval to proceed pending engineering plans and documents to be supplied by the property owner attesting to proper loads; proper design and support, and a load limit as required by regulation.


Attached is a map of the County road.


LOCATION MAP
