NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TUESDAY, MARCH 17, 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sierra County Board of Supervisors will conduct the following public hearings **on Tuesday, March 17, 2026**, at 105 Beckwith Street, Social Hall, Loyalton, CA. Interested persons are urged to attend.

- **10:00 a.m. – Blake GPA ZA WA contract (amendment): Lucy Blake (Property Owner):** Consideration of a General Plan Amendment to change the land use designation on 720 acres of forest land from “Agriculture” to “Forest,” and a Zone Amendment to put 562 acres in Timber Production Zone (TPZ). The project area additionally is in a Williamson Act Contract, which will be amended to exclude the TPZ lands. The proposed site is located at 222 Lemon Canyon Road, Sierraville, on a 1,272.6-ac. ranch (APN 018-030-002, 018-030-005, and 018-030-006). Planning staff’s preliminary environmental assessment: statutorily exempt under California Government Code §51119.5 and CEQA Guidelines §15061(b)(3).
- **11:00 a.m. – Sierra County (nonrenewal of Williamson Act Contract 73-8):** Consideration of nonrenewal of California Land Conservation Act Contract or “Williamson Act Contract” 73-8, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 21, 1972. The contract includes APN 023-010-006, 019-070-004, 019-070-005, and 018-120-014 near Stampede Reservoir in eastern Sierra County, and was jointly managed but now held by separate owners; APN 023-010-006 is now under federal ownership who wishes out of the contract. Preliminary environmental assessment: CEQA Guidelines §15061(b)(3).

Members of the public may provide public comment during the hearing and may submit written comments on this matter by U.S. Mail or email at clerk-recorder@sierracounty.ca.gov. The Board of Supervisors will consider all written comments received prior to the posted hearing date.
