## NOVEMBER 8, 2016 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION

Return your ballot by mail. **NEW!** Vote-by-Mail ballots will be counted if Postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the Sierra County Clerk's Office no later than 3 days after Election Day. To ensure your Vote-by-Mail ballot is postmarked and received timely by the Election's Office, please refer to the last date and time to mail your Vote-by-Mail ballot at your local Post Office.
