<p><b>SEWAGE</b></p> 	<p>Our property uses a septic system for sewage disposal. Please do not flush anything except toilet paper. There are garbage cans inside the restrooms for paper towels, feminine products, baby wipes, hair, and similar items.</p>
<p><b>KITCHEN</b></p> 	<p>This home is served by a septic system. Please dispose of food in the garbage cans provided. Do not put food, grease, fats, and harmful chemicals down our sinks (or toilets).</p>
<p><b>GARBAGE REMOVAL</b></p> 	<p>We have bear-proof garbage receptacle in the back of the property. If you accumulate a full garbage bag, please tie the bag up and place inside of the bear-proof receptacle. <b>DO NOT LEAVE GARBAGE OR FOOD OUTSIDE OR IN YOUR VEHICLE.</b> We are in the woods, and there are lots of mountain lions, raccoons, and bears. This measure is for your safety. We remove the trash once a week and at the beginning and end of every booking.</p>
