Local Agency Formation Commission of Sierra County Notice of Public Member Vacancy

The Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) of Sierra County currently has two vacancies:

- One (1) vacancy of a public member, and
- One (1) vacancy of an alternate public member

Sierra LAFCo is a five (5) member public board and a governmental agency that is independent of county government, consisting of: two (2) members of the Sierra County Board of Supervisors, two (2) members of the Loyalton City Council, and one (1) public member appointed by the rest of the Commission (plus alternate members of each).

A LAFCo for each county in California was established in accordance with the policies and procedures established by the State Legislature under the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, Sections 56000 et seq. of the California Government Code, whose principal responsibilities are to review and approve proposed local government changes of organization—including the formation and changes to the boundaries of districts for the provision of public services (such as water districts, fire districts, city boundaries, county service areas, etc.). Among the purposes of LAFCo are: the discouragement of urban sprawl; preservation of open space; and to encourage orderly development and the efficient extension of governmental services.

Those interested in serving as a public commission member or an alternate public commission member of LAFCo should submit an application and/or letter of interest, including past experience that they believe qualifies them for commission membership. Application forms are available online at:
