

UNDERSTANDING EMERGENCY ALERTS

TYPE OF EMERGENCY ALERT	DESCRIPTION	HOW TO GET IT
EVERBRIDGE Emergency Alert	Landline and cell calls, emails, texts for emergencies impacting an address you enter.	Registration Required. Register online at sierracounty.ca.gov EMERGENCY ALERT BUTTON 
EVERBRIDGE Mobile Alert App	Landline and cell calls, emails, texts for emergencies impacting your home address or location through an app on your phone.	Download required. Visit your app store and search for "Everbridge Emergency Alerts & Nixle."
NIXLE	Text alerts to your cellphone related to each zip code you provide.	Text your zip code to 888777 to opt-in.
Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA)	Notification to your cellphone based on your physical location.	No registration required. <i>Coverage may be limited in Sierra County.</i> This alert is issued by local government as part of the Integrated Public Alert & Warning System.
Emergency Alert System	Alerts radio listeners and TV viewers.	No registration required. <i>Coverage may be limited in Sierra County.</i> This alert is issued by local government as part of the Integrated Public Alert & Warning System.
Zonehaven AWARE aka Genasys	Non-Alerting system displaying Evacuation Zones & Realtime Status	No registration required. Simply go to protect.genasys.com and enter your address to see your zone and it's current status. 
Hi-Lo Siren	Alerts neighborhoods of an Evacuation Order using a European-style, two-tone siren.	Instructions may be issued over the loud speaker.
