Resolution 2023-

WHEREAS, the Sierra County Personnel Code, Chapter 3.09.010 (G) limits maximum vacation accrual and carry over per years of services, and

WHEREAS, employees whose vacation balances exceed the limits are not allowed to accrue further vacation until the leave balance is reduced below the cap; and,

WHEREAS, Sheriff’s office employees who have accumulated the maximum number of hours prior to January 1, 2023 to current and had intended to reduce those hours by taking vacation leave, were unable to do so due to understaffing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Auditor is hereby authorized to restore/extend vacation leave accrual overages to Sheriff Office staff with a sunset date of December 31, 2023, as requested by the Sheriff.
