Subject: Concerns about trail signage for facial covering public health orders

Dear Sierra County Board of Supervisors and Sierra County Public Health,

I'm writing because Covid has surged in California, with the highest number of cases in a day yesterday: <https://www.nytimes.com/2020/06/29/us/california-coronavirus-reopening.html>

And, a 29% jump in hospitalizations in 2 weeks.

Masks have been shown to reduce transmission, but are still not worn consistently.

I'm writing to advocate for signage at all the trailheads (or at least the PCT and also trailheads that have parking lots and bathrooms) asking people to honor the state and local public health orders by distancing when possible and carrying a facial covering, and putting it on when approaching others. Even a laminated plastic sign (similar to the ones announcing distances to various lakes, perhaps attached to the same poles), would help. I've noticed the signs are not up yet, and many trail users do not honor the state and local mask ordinances. I'm thinking that signage about protecting others on the trail, is at least as important as the distance to a particular lake or trail junction?
