**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA, CALIFORNIA AMENDING
SECTION 2.56.010 OF THE SIERRA COUNTY CODE SEPARATING THE
OFFICES OF COUNTY AUDITOR, TREASURER, AND TAX COLLECTOR**

ORDINANCE NO. 1136

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance Section One:

Section 2.56.010, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.56.010 TREASURER/TAX COLLECTOR

Pursuant to Cal. Gov't. Code § 24301 the offices and duties of the Auditor, Treasurer, and Tax Collector are separated, and the offices and duties of the Treasurer and Tax Collector are reconsolidated; provided, however, that said separation and reconsolidation shall be effective June 25, 2025. Commencing on said date, the office of Auditor shall be a separate office from the office of Treasurer and Tax Collector.

Ordinance Section Two:

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors, voting for and against the ordinance in the Mountain Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.
