

## NOTICE OF ELECTION AND NOTICE TO SUBMIT ARGUMENTS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that at the Statewide Direct Primary Election to be held on June 5, 2018, the following measure will be submitted to the voters of Sierra County:

### MEASURE A

“Shall a measure imposing a prohibition on commercial marijuana cultivation, commercial marijuana processing, and marijuana dispensaries within Sierra County be adopted?”

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any written arguments for or against the measure to be submitted to the voters must be filed with the County Clerk’s Office, P.O. Drawer D, 100 Courthouse Sq., Room 11, Downieville, CA 95936, no later than 5 p.m. on February 2, 2018. Arguments shall not exceed 300 words and must be accompanied with a signed statement that the argument is true and correct, which is available from County Clerk’s Office or online at [www.sierracounty.ca.gov/elections](http://www.sierracounty.ca.gov/elections).

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** there will be a 10-calendar-day public examination period for arguments commencing February 5, 2018 thru February 15, 2018, during which a qualified voter of the jurisdiction may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that if an argument in favor of and an argument against the measure is submitted, copies will be mailed to the respective authors in order that they may submit a rebuttal argument. The deadline for filing a rebuttal argument will be 5 p.m. on February 16, 2018. Rebuttal arguments shall not exceed 250 words.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** there will be a 10-calendar-day public examination period for arguments commencing February 20, 2018 thru March 2, 2018, during which a qualified voter of the jurisdiction may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.
