

ATTENTION VOTERS

The Sierra County Registrar of Voters would like to remind all voters that the Assembly District 1 Special Primary Election will be held on August 27, 2019. All Sierra County voting precincts have been designated as “all mailed” ballot precincts for this election. This means that all Sierra County voters will be receiving a vote-by-mail ballot. Please look for your vote-by-mail ballot in the mail the week of **July 29, 2019**.

Remember the last day to register to vote for the August 27, 2019, Assembly District 1 Special Primary Election is **August 12, 2019**. If you move to a new residence address within the county or need to register to vote after this deadline, you will have the opportunity to register and vote a conditional provisional ballot by visiting the Sierra County Clerk’s Office. Return your ballot by mail. Vote-by-mail ballots will be counted if postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the Sierra County Clerk's Office no later than 3 days after Election Day.

Return your ballot in person. A drop box will be available at the **Loyalton City Hall Auditorium** at 605 School Street from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day or you can bring your ballot to the Sierra County Clerk's Office in Downieville. Your ballot must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
